Workshop I: Wiki Workshop for Korean K12 teachers

Abstract

“A wiki” is a webpage or set of web pages that can be easily edited by anyone who is allowed to access. Comparing with other Information and Communication Technology (ICT) tools, wiki is a-free-for-all where content is shaped by anyone with editing rights. From the educational perspectives, it will enhance the interactivity and collaboration in Learning Management Systems (LMS) as the integration of wiki into LMS seems to become more popular and successful in the secondary education settings. Driven by this trend, this workshop is designed to support the Korean language teachers to use their own wiki site as a collaborative resource sharing tool. Through this workshop, teachers will be able to effectively use the Korean teachers’ resource wiki with better understanding of the ICT tools.

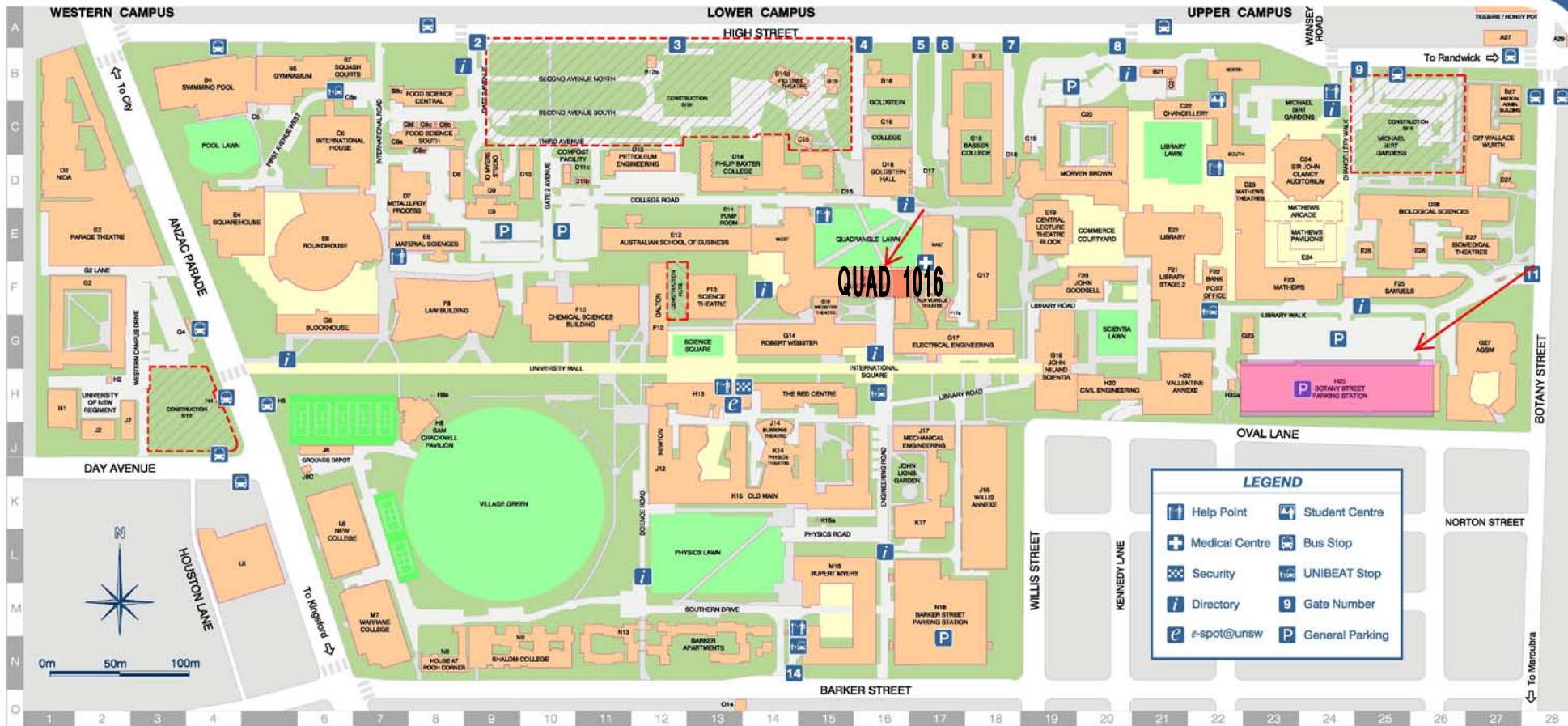
Workshop II: Online Tools and Resources for Korean Language Teaching

Abstract

A large number of online learning and teaching tools are currently available for use in the area of second/foreign language education. This workshop presents selected online tools and resources for Korean language teaching and provides participants with opportunities to explore them. It also discusses how Web-based language learning can be implemented in the Korean language classroom.
